Discussion	:	1. After due discussion the agenda was approved 2. In agenda no-2, 3, 4, 5 the syllabus for BL-506, BL-606, BL-505, BL-603 & BL-701 have been modified. During modification and as per the observation of the Faculty Members along with the expert opinion from Justice Rajesh Chandra it was felt that scheme of papers needs modifications and IPR Course needs more weightage. Therefore apart from the modifications in the course contents as above following modifications have been made in the B.A.LL.B. Ordinance:- a) First three semester have been suggested no change. b) In fourth semester BL-404, BL-406, BL-506, BL-405 have been renamed as BL-403, BL-404, BL-405 & BL-406 respectively alongwith the modified course content as per agenda no-02. c) In fifth semester BL-1001 has been divided in two parts and one is placed as BL-502 & BL-606 has been placed has BL-506, respectively alongwith the modified course content as per agenda no-02 & as per new course content submitted by Dr. Vaibhav Goel Bhartiya for BL-502. In the semester course content of BL-505 has modified as per agenda no-03 and approved. d) In sixth semester the second part of IPR which was in one part in BL-1001 has been placed as BL-602, BL-801 has been placed as BL-604 and BL-1002 has been placed BL-606, respectively alongwith the modified course content submitted by Dr. Vaibhav Goel Bhartiya for BL-602. In the semester course content of BL-603 has modified as per agenda no-04 and approved. e) In seventh semester course content of BL-701 has modified as per agenda no-05 and approved. In the semester the nomenclature of BL-705 has been slightly modified as Banking Laws (IBC) in place of Banking Laws.

	<p>f) In eight semester course BL-803 of constitutional law optional group has been recommended to be the compulsory core course and kept as BL-801, whereas BL-604 which was compulsory core course was recommended to be part of constitutional law optional group as BL-803</p> <p>g) In tenth semester course code BL-1001 and BL-1002 were shifted as BL-502 & 602 and BL-606. Therefore course code BL-403, BL-502, BL-602 (Minor Acts) has been shifted to tenth semester as BL-1001. Here the course content of BL-403 & BL-502 was mixed and converted in to one five credit course named as Logic and Reasoning & Legal General Studies as course code BL-1001. In this semester students were given choice to opt either 'Logic and Reasoning & Legal General Studies' or 'Minor Acts'. The course code for Minor Acts is given as BL-1002.</p> <p>3. After few modifications the agenda was approved and Dr. Sarika Tyagi is accepted to submit the modified program.</p>


