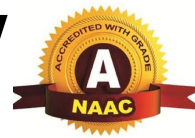

It was resolved that there is a requirement for changes in marking scheme, assessment pedagogy, and addition-deletion of few courses etc. It was further resolved that all the faculty members will work on the course outline and addition of case laws as a part of course outline which need proper time.

Therefore it was resolved that the modification suggested as above will remain on hold and will be submitted during April-2026 after incorporation of all the suggestions and after proper analysis of the courses in various legal institute of repute. It was added that in the new structure marks/credit for summer and winter internship (10%) or Moot Court participation (10%), court room observation (10%) or field work (10%) will be added. Moot Court participation (10%), Project/Memorial/Case Comment (15%) and Attendance (05%) The Final end term examination will carry maximum weightage of 50 marks.
